Please forgive me for not having reminders to you last week. I received news Thursday that my grandfather had passed away. I left for Missouri that afternoon and did not have access to my laptop. Thank You to those of you who have offered your condolences. And many thanks to your children who have been very understanding and kind.

\*Our 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade bands will be performing their annual Fall concert at Berea High School on Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>. Call time for students is 6 P.M. with the concert beginning at 7. Doors will open for parents at 6:45 P.M. Typically, our concerts are at Travelers Rest High School. Unfortunately, we were not able to secure the auditorium there for our requested date. Dress for students is concert black. For those of you who our new to our band, concert black is: black shirt, black pants, black socks, and black shoes. Ladies may wear a black skirt or dress as long as the length is below the knees when standing.

\*On October 22<sup>nd</sup>, our 7<sup>th</sup> grade band will have an after school rehearsal from 3:30 until 4:45 P.M. This is so our full band can perform together once before our Fall concert one week from then.

\*On October 27<sup>th</sup>, our 6<sup>th</sup> grade band will have an after school rehearsal from 3:30 until 4:45 P.M. I for one am excited to see 81 students performing music together! This will allow for an outstanding Fall program.

\*The Limestone Invitational Band Clinic – I have had several students express an interest in this clinic again this year. \*Region One Honor Band Auditions – These will be held on Saturday, January 9<sup>th</sup> at Greer High School. \*Greenville All-County Honor Band Auditions – These auditions will be held on Monday, January 11<sup>th</sup>. The clinic will be held on Thursday, February 25<sup>th</sup> and Friday, February 26<sup>th</sup> at Riverside High School. Audition requirements are slightly different than region band auditions for some instruments. Please see the other document attached with this email.

\*Audition Fee – Both of these events require a \$10 audition fee for each (i.e. \$20 total). I always advise students to take both auditions because they are virtually the same process and this doubles the students' chances of making one of the bands. Not only are these honor bands a great musical experience, they also look great on a college application (even in middle school). I hope many students will consider auditioning! If there

is a financial issue with registration fees, please bring this to my attention and we will see what can be done to make sure every student who would like the opportunity may have it.
